Subtitle: *7 Places He Bled — 1 Complete Redemption*

Opening Statement

Good Friday is not just about how much Jesus suffered...
It's about how *specific* His sacrifice was.

Jesus didn't just die — **He bled on purpose.**

- Every place He bled...was intentional
- was prophetic
- and speaks to something in our lives today

Core Scriptures

Isaiah 53:5 (ESV)

“But he was pierced for our transgressions;
he was crushed for our iniquities;
upon him was the chastisement that brought us peace,
and with his wounds we are healed.”

Hebrews 9:22 (ESV)

“Indeed, under the law almost everything is purified with blood, and without the shedding of blood there is no forgiveness of sins.”

1 Peter 1:18–19 (ESV)

“...knowing that you were ransomed from the futile ways inherited from your forefathers, not with perishable things such as silver or gold, but with the precious blood of Christ, like that of a lamb without blemish or spot.”

Big Idea

The blood of Jesus doesn't just save us — it restores every part of us.

1. HIS HEAD — CROWN OF THORNS

Matthew 27:29 (ESV)

“And twisting together a crown of thorns, they put it on his head and put a reed in his right hand...”

John 19:2 (ESV)

“And the soldiers twisted together a crown of thorns and put it on his head...”

Genesis 3:17–18 (ESV)

“Cursed is the ground because of you... thorns and thistles it shall bring forth for you...”

Application

- Jesus wore the curse on His head

- He bled for your **mind**

- Anxiety
- Fear
- Shame

Anchor: He wore a crown of pain so you can have peace of mind.

2. HIS BACK — THE SCOURGING

John 19:1 (ESV)

“Then Pilate took Jesus and flogged him.”

Isaiah 53:5 (ESV)

“...with his wounds we are healed.”

Psalms 129:3 (ESV)

“The plowers plowed upon my back; they made long their furrows.”

1 Peter 2:24 (ESV)

“By his wounds you have been healed.”

Application

- Jesus bled from His back for **healing**

- Physical
- Emotional
- Spiritual

3. HIS HANDS — NAILED

Luke 23:33 (ESV)

“And when they came to the place that is called The Skull, there they crucified him...”

John 20:25 (ESV)

“Unless I see in his hands the mark of the nails... I will never believe.”

Psalm 22:16 (ESV)

“...they have pierced my hands and feet...”

Application

- Hands represent what we've done
- **Left hand** → **my past** (sin, mistakes)
- **Right hand** → **my future** (purpose, calling)
- Jesus bled to redeem both

Anchor: The same hands that were pierced now hold your future.

4. HIS FEET — NAILED

Luke 23:33 (ESV)

“...there they crucified him...”

Psalm 22:16 (ESV)

“...they have pierced my hands and feet...”

Isaiah 52:7 (ESV)

“How beautiful upon the mountains are the feet of him who brings good news...”

Ephesians 2:10 (ESV)

“For we are his workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works... that we should walk in them.”

Application

- Jesus bled from His feet for your **walk**
- Direction
- Decisions
- Purpose
- You are not stuck. God has a path for you.

5. HIS SIDE — PIERCED

John 19:34 (ESV)

“But one of the soldiers pierced his side with a spear, and at once there came out blood and water.”

Zechariah 12:10 (ESV)

“...they will look on me, on him whom they have pierced...”

1 John 5:6 (ESV)

“This is he who came by water and blood—Jesus Christ...”

Hebrews 10:19–20 (ESV)

“...we have confidence to enter the holy places by the blood of Jesus... through the curtain, that is, through his flesh.”

Application

- Blood → forgiveness
- Water → cleansing & new life
- His side was opened so we could have **access to God**
- *He bled there... for me.*

Build

The blood speaks:

- Peace for your mind
- Healing for your body
- Forgiveness for your past
- Purpose for your future
- Direction for your life
- Access to God

Nothing in your life is untouched by His sacrifice
